

## **Executive Session Minutes**

**October 28, 2014**

**St. Clair Township**

At 8:18 p.m. during the regular meeting Trustee Sturgis made the motion to go into executive session pursuant to Section 2(c)(2) of the Open Meeting Act regarding union negotiations. Supervisor Barnes seconded the motion. Roll call vote. Yes – Carroll, Sturgis, Barnes. No – Wells, Hipskind. Motion passed.

The executive session was called to order at 8:22 p.m.

Present at the meeting were Supervisor Barnes; Trustees Carroll, Wells, Sturgis, and Hipskind; Clerk Reed; and Attorney Robert Seigel with the Lowenbaum Partnership, LLC.

Attorney Seigel attended the meeting in the stead of Attorney Michael Lowenbaum, the township's attorney during union negotiations.

Supervisor Barnes confirmed all board members had seen the Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated with the help of the mediator at the Illinois Labor Relations Board.

Supervisor Barnes said Mr. Lowenbaum recommended accepting the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

Attorney Seigel explained the mediation process.

The board discussed some of the details of the agreement and the costs to the township.

At 8:39 p.m. Trustee Hipskind made a motion to move out of executive session and return to the regular meeting to vote on the Collective Bargaining Agreement. Trustee Sturgis seconded the motion. Roll call vote. All in favor.
